

## **Objective or Outcome??**

Graduates of the new training module will be able to explain the history, traditions, and important facts and resources of UGA to prospective students and families.

Facilitate community development in residence halls.

Graduates of the new training module will demonstrate effective communication and group facilitation skills during campus tours.

Participants will report satisfactory experiences with their tour guide and the quality and delivery of the campus tour as outlined by training outcomes.

The program will increase awareness of sexual violence issues facing college students.

Students will correctly apply etiquette concepts learned in Career Development class to a mock interview setting.

75% of the current members of the tour guides program in 2006-2007 will remain members the following year.

Demonstrate an understanding of assessment language & literature in seminar discussions, one minute messages, and small group activities

Define, plan, and present a draft of an assessment project

Increase ability to prepare and perform an assessment project

Develop a greater understanding of assessment in student affairs and higher education

Increase participation in Georgia Outdoor Recreation Programs by 25%.

Participants will understand the professional development needs of entry-level employees in student affairs.

Connect freshman and sophomores with the resources of the Career Center via a bi-monthly e-newsletter.

Students will describe their personal leadership style and identify its strengths and weaknesses.
