

DawgCheck is UGA's easy-to-use, COVID-19 reporting tool. Report exposures, a positive COVID-19 test, or check your symptoms at **dawgcheck.uga.edu**.

WHEN SHOULD YOU USE DAWGCHECK?

- If you test positive for COVID-19, you are **REQUIRED** to report it.
- If you have been in close contact with someone with COVID-19 and are unvaccinated or if it has been over three months since you've had COVID-19, use DawgCheck to check your symptoms and learn next steps.

WHO NEEDS TO USE DAWGCHECK?

DawgCheck is for all UGA students, staff and faculty members. Campus visitors are also welcome to use DawgCheck.

WHY SHOULD YOU USE DAWGCHECK?

- The health and safety of the UGA community is our top priority.
- If you test positive, you can share names of close contacts to help DPH with contact tracing.
- In addition to getting vaccinated, using DawgCheck will help protect fellow Bulldogs and the communities surrounding campus against the spread of COVID-19.
